

Note on above. The difference between Pitch 1p in metric (=25.4 turns per inch) and 26 Turns per inch is so small that it is difficult to tell the difference. In fact the nuts are generally interchangeable. You can tell the difference on bolts/shafts by placing them next to each other and comparing.
